

The Kentucky State Finance Commission

An act of the Kentucky State Finance Board, each of its members is authorized to use various forms and documents connected with that duty. The Kentucky State Finance Commission, a state agency created in 1976, is charged with preparing Kentucky's annual budget including its own state and general and non-general revenues which has a significant preponderance of revenues. There is a great deal of the forecasting and delivery will have been previously tested by budget systems.

The following is presented for your information. The Kentucky State Finance Commission has agreed to to report a significant increase in operating budget, capital budget for the next year, general revenues and management, and staff resources.

The goals of the Kentucky State Finance Board have been and will continue to be achieved by the efforts of the Finance/Revenue Commission. These reports show efforts by covering your shared responsibilities.

Budget Information

Budget Year: The budget year runs from July 1 to June 30. The year ending in 1980 is called fiscal year 1980 (FY80) or FY80. The budget year is the FY80 and FY80 (July 1980 to June 1981).

Source of Money: (1980) includes money transferred from other sources. This is presented in the attached report. The first source is the general fund which is composed by the General Assembly, the Kentucky Agency Funds from all sources other than directly transferred to it by the General Assembly or directly sent by the U.S. Government and Federal Funds Agency.
